The Coffee County Legislative Body met January 12, 2021 in a regular scheduled meeting at the Coffee County Administrative Plaza at 6:00 PM.

Motion made by Debellis and seconded by Tildon Stubblefield to approve Jeremy Jernigan to the Agriculture Committee replacing Basil Hockett whose term expired and is also deceased. Upon roll call the motion was approved with 21 yes votes.

Motion made by Debellis and seconded by Tim Stubblefield to approve Dr. Al Brandon as County Coroner. Upon roll call the motion was approved with 21 yes votes.

Motion made by Crabtree and seconded by Orrick to appoint Don Purinton as Veterans Service Officer. Upon roll call the motion was approved with 21 yes votes.

Motion made by Orrick and seconded by DeFord to approve the Coffee County Road Report. Upon roll call the motion was approved with 21 yes votes.

Motion made by Orrick and seconded by Crabtree to approve the 2022 Fiscal Year Budget Calendar. Upon roll call the motion was approved with 21 yes votes.

Motion made by Orrick and seconded by Sebourn to approve the following Budget Amendments: #CARES-2021-07 Tennessee CARES Relief Fund, #118-2021-08 Ambulance Fund, #101-2021-09 General Fund, #171-2021-10 General Capital Projects and #101-2021-11. Upon roll call the motion was approved with 21 yes votes.

Motion made by Crabtree and seconded by Duncan for the adoption of Resolution 2021-01 State Acquisition of Martin Methodist College establishing a fourth undergraduate campus of the University of Tennessee System. Upon roll call the motion was approved with 21 yes votes.

There being no further business the County Legislative Body adjourned.
