

May 11, 2021 Minutes

The Coffee County Legislative Body met May 11, 2021 in a regular scheduled meeting at the Coffee County Administrative Plaza at 6:00 PM.

Sheriff Chad Partin proclaimed the meeting open for business.

Jackie Duncan gave the Invocation and Rosemary Crabtree led the Pledge to the Flag.

There were 18 members present for the meeting with Jim Fielding, Joey Hobbs and Lynn Sebourn being absent.

Mayor Cordell requested the agenda be amended by adding 11d litigation on Bonaroo annexation and making 11e other. Motion made by Kraft and seconded by Miller to approve the agenda as amended. The motion was approved with 17 yes votes and Debellis abstained.

Public comments were held.

Motion made by Deford and seconded by Kraft to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.

Motion made by Crabtree and seconded by Deford to approve the following members of the Equalization Board: Stan Teal, Jesse Bray, Allen Griggs, Ed Holland, Ronnie Lee Sullivan, II and John Bell (alternate). The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.


Motion made by Duncan and seconded by Cunningham to approve the Forensic Telecommunication Risk Free Audit Agreement. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.

Motion made by Kraft and seconded by Tim Stubblefield to approve the Tybera Development Group, Inc. Software as a service (SaaS) agreement for Coffee County, TN – Chancery Court and for Circuit Court. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.

Motion made by Ray and seconded by Kraft to direct County Attorney Robert Huskey to file litigation pertaining to the annexation of the Bonnaroo property and take all action necessary to protect the county's interest regarding tax funds. The motion was approved with 13 yes votes and 5 no votes. Voting no were Debellis, Hollandsworth, Morse, Hunt and Crabtree.

There being no further business the County Legislative Body adjourned.
