

June 28, 2022 Minutes

The Coffee County Legislative Body met June 28, 2022 in a regular scheduled meeting at the Coffee County Administrative Plaza at 6:00 PM.

Sheriff Chad Partin proclaimed the meeting open for business.

Roy Slaughter from the Hillsboro First Baptist Church gave the Invocation and Jackie Duncan led the Pledge to the Flag.

There were 17 members present for the meeting with Jimmy Hollandsworth, Jeff Keele, Barbara Poston and Lynn Sebourn being absent.

Mayor Cordell requested to amend the agenda by deleting item 11g) and adding under 11c) budget amendment #116-2022-24. Motion made by Orrick and seconded by Crabtree to approve the agenda as amended. The motion was approved with 17 yes votes.

Motion made by Debellis and seconded by Orrick for the approval of the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion was approved with 17 yes votes.

Motion made by Orrick and seconded by Bryan for the adoption of Resolution 2022-22 to construct a new Coffee County Consolidated Health Department in the Coffee County Joint Industrial Park. The motion was approved with 17 yes votes.

Motion made by Orrick and seconded by Tim Stubblefield for the adoption of Resolution 2022-23 to increase the level of purchasing authority of the Coffee County Full Time Purchasing Agent. The motion was approved with 17 yes votes.

Motion made by Orrick and seconded by Crabtree for the approval of the following budget amendments #101-2022-23 General Fund, #131-2022-24 Highway/Public Works Fund and #116-2022-224 Solid Waste/Sanitation. The motion was approved with 17 yes votes.

Amendment made by Bryan and seconded by Cunningham to reflect line items presented in the revised General Fund, Ambulance and Capital Project Funds for the Mayor's office to be changed from \$420,362.00 to \$427,554.00 and Animal

Control Revised General Fund to be changed from \$135,161.00 to 139,509.00. The motion was approved with 16 yes votes and Kraft voting no.

Motion made by Bryan and seconded by Orrick for the approval of Resolution 2022-24 making appropriation for the Various Funds, Departments, Institutions, Offices and Agencies of Coffee County, Tennessee for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023. Amendment made by Morse and seconded by Ray to amend Resolution 2022-24 from a 5 per cent pay increase to a 7 ½ per cent increase. The amendment failed with 9 yes votes and 7 no votes and 1 abstained. Yes, votes were Debellis, Morse, Hobbs, Hunt, Kraft, Ray, Deford, Tildon Stubblefield and Duncan. No, votes were Bryan, Orrick, Taylor, Smith, Miller, Tim Stubblefield and Crabtree. Cunningham abstained. The motion to approve Resolution 2022-24 was approved with 15 yes votes with Debellis and Morse voting no.

Motion made by Bryan and seconded by Orrick for the approval of Resolution 2022-25 setting the Tax Levy in Coffee County, Tennessee for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2022. The motion was approved with 17 yes votes.

Motion made by Hunt and seconded by Crabtree for the adoption of Resolution 2022-27 to increase the Compensation of the County Attorney. The motion was approved with 15 yes votes and Kraft and Ray voting no.

There being no further business the Legislative Body adjourned.
