

May 13, 2014 Corrected Copy

The Coffee County Legislative Body met May 13, 2014 in a regular scheduled meeting at the Coffee County Administrative Plaza at 6:00 PM.

Sheriff Steve Graves proclaimed the meeting open for business.

The Invocation was given by Jackie Duncan and the Pledge to the Flag was led by Steven Jones.

There were 18 members present for the meeting with Warren Walker, Janet Fann and Gail Hines being absent.

Commissioner Thacker requested to add the closing of Underwood Rd to the agenda under New Business (10f other). Motion made by West and seconded by Kelly to approve the agenda with this addition. The motion was approved with 17 yes votes and Alford voting no.

Motion made by Alford and seconded by West to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.

Motion made by Bricken and seconded by West to approve the following notaries as listed: Christine Marie Anderjack, Brenda Faye Ashby, Tiffany Barnes, Whitney Brazier, Deborah R. Bryant, Stephanie Jo Dowdy, Anita J. Hargrove, Penny Harrell, Deanie Keele, Marie McDonald, Randall W. Morrison, Regina Myers, Ashley Weddington Nelson, Sheri M. ONeal, Sheena Pratt, Brooke Boyles Shasteen and Ronald Worthington. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.

Motion made by Duckett and seconded by Bricken for the adoption of Resolution #2014-06 authorizing a continuous four (4) year reappraisal cycle. The motion was approved with 16 yes votes and Alford and West voted no.

Motion made by Morris and seconded by Duckett for the adoption of Resolution #2014-08 to amend Coffee County Zoning Resolution #2006-39, Article 4.046-B by

deleting and adding a permitted use. The motion was approved with 14 yes votes and 4 no votes. Voting no were Jones, Chance, West and Kidd.

Motion made by Morris and seconded by Duncan for the adoption of Resolution 2014-09 to amend Coffee County Zoning Resolution #2006-39 to rezone property along the southeasterly side of Highway 55 from the end of the City Limits at the Caterpillar property proceeding along that margin of the roadway toward Tullahoma a distance of 1.5 miles and from the roadway margin a depth of 500 feet from RS-1 (Low Density Residential) to C-1 (General Commercial District). The motion was approved with 17 yes votes and West voted no.

Motion made by Morris and seconded by Duckett for the adoption of Resolution #2014-10 to amend Coffee County Zoning Resolution #2006-39 to rezone a 10 acre tract at the corner of Vaughn Speckleman Road from RS-1 (Low Density Residential) to M-1 (General Industrial District). The motion was approved with 17 yes votes and Alford abstained.

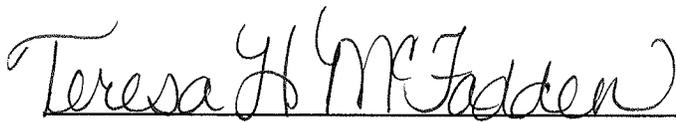
Motion made by Bricken and seconded by Kelly to approve the following budget amendments: #101-2014-12 General Fund, #152-2014-013 Rural Debt Service, #101-2014-014 General Fund and #122-2014-15 Drug Enforcement. The motion was approved with 17 yes votes and Chance voted no.

Motion made by Bricken and seconded by Patton for the adoption of Resolution 2014-11 to place consideration of the levy of a Motor Vehicle Privilege Tax to referendum on the August ballot. After discussion an amendment was made by Bricken and seconded by Kelly to put \$50.00 in the last paragraph on the first page to read "to enact a \$50 Motor Vehicle Privilege Tax" and on page 2 under "Be it further resolved insert \$50 Motor Vehicle Privilege Tax." The motion to amend was approved with 16 yes votes and Alford and Kidd voted no. Motion made by Kelly and seconded by Chance to suspend the Rules of the Commission to let the public speak. The motion was approved with 17 yes votes and Thacker voted no. David Welborn, Tim Brown, Dwight Miller and Diane Knight made comments. A vote was then held on the original motion to approve Resolution 2014-11 as amended. The motion failed with 10 yes votes and 8 no votes. Yes votes were: Wilma Thomas, Bobby Bryan, Kerry Farrar, Lee Duckett, Tim Morris,

Rennie Bell, Keith Thacker, Jimmy Bradford, Jackie Duncan and Rush Bricken. No votes were Steven Jones, Sam Mai, Eric Chance, Virgil Alford, Barry West, Mark Kelly, Myra Patton and Gary Kidd.

Motion made by Thacker and seconded by West to close Underwood Road. After discussion motion made by Alford and seconded by Patton to postpone this until the next meeting. The motion to postpone passed with 12 yes vote and Mai, Bryan, West, Morris, Bell and Thacker voted no.

There being no further business the Legislative Body adjourned.
