

May 12, 2015

The Coffee County Legislative Body met May 12, 2015 in a regular scheduled meeting at the Coffee County Administrative Plaza at 6:00 PM.

Captain Frank Watkins proclaimed the meeting open for business.

The Invocation was given by Kimberly Martin and the Pledge to the Flag was led by Barbara Buckner.

There were 20 members present for the meeting with Warren Walker being absent.

Mayor Cordell amended the agenda by adding Ambulance Authority under item 8b and moving other to 8C. Motion made by Kelly and seconded by Shelton to approve the agenda as amended. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Cunningham and seconded by Crockett to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Bricken and seconded by Duncan to approve the following notaries as listed: Jamie S. Coleman, Helen Joe DeBellis, Gerald L. Ewell, Jr, Paula Jo Fetter, Steven K. Gilbert, Jackie F. Hershman, Jennifer L. Jones, Amelia B. Messick, Cindy R. Nadeau, Laura W. Noe, Teresa A. Polce, Barbara Sims, Teresa J. Sullivan, Ronnie Lee Sullivan, II, Tracy Smith Tabor, Teresa Walter, Gabriela West, Gladys Wright and John T. Zakesak. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Recommendation of the Manchester Caucus is for Dr. Florence to replace Warren Walker to the Ambulance Authority due to scheduling conflicts that prohibits Mr. Walker from attending the meetings. Motion made by Jones and seconded by Duncan to approve Dr. Florence to the Ambulance Authority to fill the unexpired term of Walker ending in July 2016. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes with Farrar voting no and Martin abstained.

Charlie Curtiss, Executive Director of the County Commissioners Association was present for the meeting to introduce him and offer his assistance at anytime.

Also, he gave a brief report on some Legislative Bills and announced the new webinar training being offered for the Commissioners by CTAS.

Motion made by Kelly and seconded by Jones for the adoption of Resolution 2015-18 to prohibit resale of entertainment admission tickets or tokens. The motion was approved with 19 yes votes and Bricken voted no.

Motion made by Morris and seconded by Mai for the adoption of Resolution 2015-19 to opt out of 2009 International Property Maintenance Code. An amendment was made by Argraves and seconded by Shelton to defer until the next meeting and ask the Mayor discuss with Judges any issues. Speer asked to see how many written complaints have been filed. This was accepted as part of the motion by Argraves and Shelton. Bricken stated this was a rural issue and would like to see some Committee put it on their agenda before the next meeting. The motion to postpone was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Morris and seconded by Bryan for the adoption of Resolution 2015-20 to opt out of Section R313 Automatic Fire Sprinkler Systems of the 2009 International Residential Code. The motion was approved with 19 yes votes and Stubblefield voted no.

Motion made by Morris and seconded by Shelton for the adoption of Resolution 2015-21 to Amend Coffee County Zoning Resolution No. 2006-39 to rezone the Property currently owned by Bobby and Vicki Gilley located on Murfreesboro Highway from C-1 Rural Center District to C-2 General Commercial District. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.



Kelly announced the Legislative Committee will be inviting Constables due to a change in the TCA to provide pros and cons and have discussions and because of that they will also invite the Road Commissioners for their input.

Kelly announced Reagan Day Dinner will be held May 29, 2015 at the Conference Center.
