

April 11, 2017 Minutes

The Coffee County Legislative Body met April 11, 2017 in a regular scheduled meeting at the Coffee County Administrative Plaza at 6:00 PM.

Sheriff Steve Graves proclaimed the meeting open for business.

Pastor Bruce Barger, from the First Baptist Church in Hillsboro gave the Invocation and Todd Crockett led the Pledge to the Flag.

Mayor Cordell introduced and welcomed Cub Scout Pack 562 to the meeting. Missy Deford invited them.

There were 20 members present for the meeting with Harold Speer being absent.

Mayor Cordell amended the agenda by removing item 10c. Motion made by Shelton and seconded by Argraves to approve the agenda as amended. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Kelly and seconded by Crabtree to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Bricken and seconded by Duncan to approve the following notaries as listed: Holli D. Avans, M. Scott Byrom, Connie L. Carter, Rhonda S. Dycus, Deanna J. Eslick, Carol A. Farris, Joshua S. Frederik, Angie Gaudet, Jeff Hartung, Keela Johnson, India Junior, Jessica Lawton, Ray E. Marcrom, Raven Pritchard, Mickelle Stamper and Christopher Williams. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Morris and seconded by Martin for the adoption of Resolution 2017-04 to amend Coffee County Zoning Resolution 2006-39 to rezone the residential property at 2345 (MAP067-Parcel 065.00) McMinnville Hwy., from RS-1 Low Density Residential District to C-2 General Commercial District. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Stubblefield and seconded by Crabtree for the adoption of Resolution 2017-05 to amend Coffee County Zoning Resolution 2006-39 to rezone the residential property at MAP 110- Parcels 121.00, 123.00 and 125.00 located on the Old Manchester Highway, from RS-1 Low Density Residential District to M-1 General Industrial District. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Bryan and seconded by Duncan for the adoption of Resolution 2017-09 to change the number of members of the Coffee County Corrections Partnership Committee. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Morris and seconded by Jones for the adoption of the Manchester Library Grant Pre-Application for NASA/Stem Grant. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Morris and seconded by Farrar for the adoption of Resolution 2017-10 authorizing submission for a litter and trash collection grant from the Tennessee Department of Transportation and authorizing the acceptance of said grant. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.


