

June 13, 2017 Minutes

The Coffee County Legislative Body met June 13, 2017 in a regular scheduled meeting at the Coffee County Administrative Plaza at 6:00 PM.

Sheriff Steve Graves proclaimed the meeting open for business.

Minister Dustin Welch gave the Invocation and Tim Stubblefield led the Pledge to the Flag.

There were 18 members present for the meeting with Warren Walker, Dennis Hunt and Tim Morris being absent.

Motion made by Argraves and seconded by Duncan to approve the agenda. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.

Motion made by Kelly and seconded by Shelton to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.

Motion made by Bricken and seconded by Crockett to approve the following notaries as listed: Christy L. Barnard, Wendy S. Batson, L. Bush, Kimberly D. Crouch, Janet Kay Felts, Stacy McGriffith, Arica L. Hulseley, Trish Lawrence, Janet B. Layne, Senandra Dartis McCullough, Carla L. Motion made by Duncan and seconded by Deford to approve Major Shelton to the Sanitation Board. The motion was approved with 17 yes votes with Shelton abstaining.

Motion made by Kelly and seconded by Argraves to approve Maribeth Hartin, Kathryn Rose and Jo Todd (rural member) to the Coffee County Lannom Library Committee and Ron Fuller (Regional Library representative) to the Coffee County Manchester Library Committee. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.

Motion made by Bryan and seconded by Crabtree for the adoption of Resolution 2017-21 to adopt a Public Records Policy for Coffee County, Tennessee. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.

Motion made by Bricken and seconded by Kelly to approve the following budget amendments: #101-2017-022 General Fund and #151-2017-023 General Debt Service Fund. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.

Bricken discussed the Preliminary Budget of Coffee County, Tennessee for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2018 and asked for discussion or suggestions from the Commissioners.

Dr. McFall, Superintendent of Schools presented the General Purpose School Fund Budget and the Central Cafeteria School Fund Budget.

Brief reports of standing Committees were given, including B & F, Legislative, HWR, Capital Outlay, Law Enforcement and Personnel & Compensation Committee.

There being no further business the County Legislative body adjourned.
