

June 27, 2017 Minutes

The Coffee County Legislative Body met June 27, 2017 in a regular scheduled meeting at the Coffee County Administrative Plaza at 6:00 PM.

Sheriff Steve Graves proclaimed the meeting open for business.

Pastor David Wall from Harmony Baptist Church in Tullahoma gave the Invocation and Sheriff Graves led the Pledge to the Flag.

There were 18 members present for the meeting with Warren Walker, Todd Crockett, David Orrick and Bobby Bryan being absent.

Motion made by Duncan and seconded by Martin to approve the agenda. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.

Motion made by Kelly and seconded by Stubblefield to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion was approved with 17 yes votes and Hunt abstained.

Motion made by Bricken and seconded by Crabtree to approve the following notaries as listed: Lester Carrick, Veronica Owens, Linda Rhudy, Marilyn C. Rodman and Mark A. Williams. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.

Motion made by Duncan and seconded by Argraves to approve George Walker and Kevin O'Connell as part time Judicial Commissioners from July 1, 2017 to December 31, 2017. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.

Motion made by Morris and seconded by Shelton to approve Mark Kelly and Missy Deford to the Ambulance Authority. The motion was approved with 16 yes votes and Deford and Kelly abstained.

Motion made by Shelton and seconded by Cunningham to reappoint Lee Duckett to the Water Wastewater Authority. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.

Motion made by Cunningham and seconded by Duncan to approve the Audit Committee Report. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.

A 2018 Fiscal Budget Update was included in the Commissioners packets for information.

Motion made by Stubblefield and seconded by Mai to approve compensation for the County Employee Certified Training Program. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.

Motion made by Crabtree and seconded by Cunningham for the approval of Budget Amendments #171-2017-024 Rural Capital Projects (Infrastructure) and #101-2017-025 General Fund. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.

Motion made by Morris and seconded by Argraves for the adoption of Resolution 2017-22 making appropriation for the Various Funds, Departments, Institutions, Offices and Agencies of Coffee County, Tennessee for the Fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017 and ending June 30, 2018. Amendment by Cunningham and seconded by Stubblefield to add a 3% employees cost of living adjustment excluding Ambulance and Sheriff Employees. After discussion, the amendment failed with 3 yes votes, 12 no votes and 2 abstained. Yes votes were Cunningham, Farrar and Stubblefield. No votes were Jones, Mai, Hunt, Morris, Shelton, Deford, Kelly, Martin, Buckner, Duncan, Crabtree and Bricken. Speer and Argraves abstained. The motion to approve the Resolution was approved with 18 yes votes.

Motion made by Morris and seconded by Bricken for the adoption of Resolution 2017-23 setting the Tax Levy in Coffee County, Tennessee for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.

Brief reports of standing Committees were given, including B & F, Legislative, HWR, Capital Outlay, Law Enforcement and Personnel & Compensation Committee.

There being no further business the County Legislative Body adjourned.
